## THE HOLY ROSARY

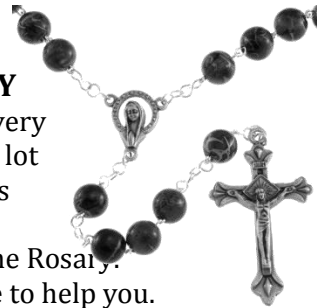
"Say the Rosary every day... Pray, pray a lot and offer sacrifices for sinners...

# Catholic Saints

Feast day ... July 18

**St. CAMILLUS DE LELLIS, PRIEST ....†1614**

St. Camillus was born in Abruzzo, Italy. A soldier addicted to gambling. He was then forced to work as a laborer at the Capuchin friary. Despite his aggressive nature & excessive gambling, the guardian friar saw a better side to his nature, and continually tried to bring that out in him. His conversion led him to found a society of religious, which established hospitals and cared for the sick.

Feast day ... July 20

**St. APOLLINARIS, Bishop, Martyr ....†1c.**

According to tradition, St. Apollinaris was a native of Antioch. He was made Bishop of Ravenna, Italy, by Saint Peter himself. The miracles, and his preaching won many converts to the Faith, while at the same time bringing upon him the fury of the idolaters, who beat him cruelly and drove him from the city.

Feast day ... July 21

**St. LAWRENCE of BRINDISI, Priest, Dr. ....†1619**

St. Lawrence, born Giulio Cesare Russo was born in Brindisi, province of Naples, Italy. A Capuchin, linguist, military chaplain, diplomat, and minister general; Learned exegete, forceful preacher, and controversialist. 15 vol.s of his writings are extant.

Feast day ... July 22

**St. MARY MAGDALENE ....†1c.**

St. Mary Magdalene a disciple of Jesus and present at his Crucifixion. In Gospel of Mark, one of the first to witness to the risen Lord. Almost universally agreed today that her being identified as the sinful woman is unfounded.

Feast day ... July 23

**St. BRIDGET ....†1c.**

St. Bridget was born in Sweden. Mystic prophet and foundress of the Order of Bridgettines. Worked for the return of the Pope to Rome.
